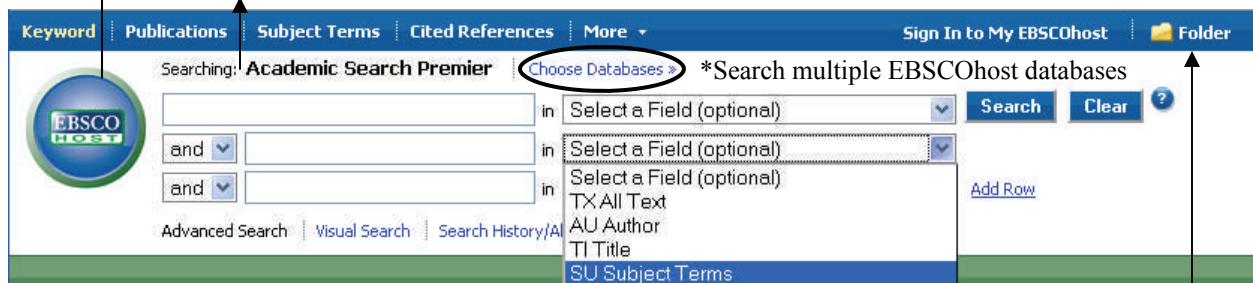

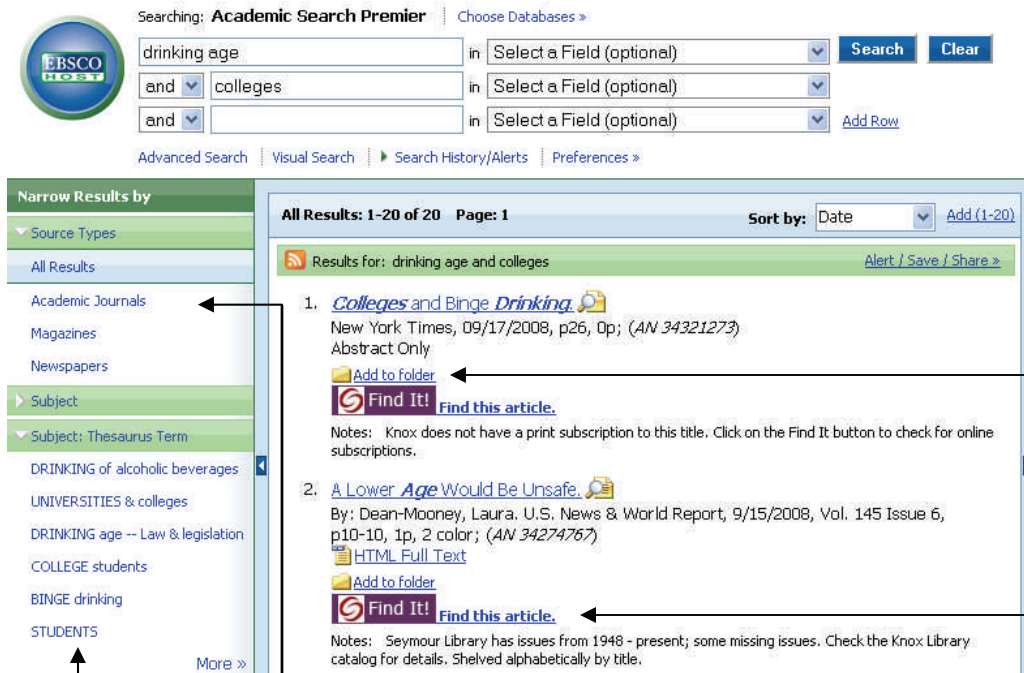


\*Do a Keyword Search by just typing your search terms into the blank fields

\*Choose how you want to search your terms by using the pull-down menu

When searching...



\*Items of interest can be temporarily stored in a **folder** by clicking on the link next to the record. After you have finished your search, you can email, print, save or export the contents of the folder.

\*Use the **Find It!** button to see if the library has access to the full text in any of the databases the library subscribes to.

\*You can limit your results to a **specific source**, such as an Academic Journal or Newspaper.

\*Find related search terms under Subject and Subject: Thesaurus Term.  
**Remember, different search terms will bring back different results!**

### Item Records

When you open an item of interest, you will find the citation information -title, source, publisher, date, length and usually an abstract.

**Abstracts** are short summaries of what the document is about. These allow you to quickly determine if the item is valuable to you or not.
