### What is JSTOR?

JSTOR is a multidisciplinary database of full-text scholarly journal articles with a strong emphasis in the Humanities and Sciences. JSTOR concentrates on complete back issues of journals and does not have current issues.

### Connecting to JSTOR

### Searching JSTOR

#### Basic Search

- Searches the full-text of the entire database (all subjects).
- Search with keywords and combine terms with AND, OR, or NOT

phenomenology  
phenomenology AND Hegel

- Search exact phrase with quotes.  
"Black Arts Movement"

**Tip:** add a \* at the end of keywords to retrieve terms with variant endings.

**For example:** phenomenolog\* = phenomenology, phenomenologist, phenomenological, etc.

#### Advanced Search

- Search within specific fields: full-text, author, article title, abstract, or caption.
- This feature works best if you want to combine multiple concepts.
- For example, if you were searching for articles about **feminism** in **poetry** during the **black arts movement**, your search may look like this:

Phrase search with quotes →

Add \* to look for feminism, feminist, etc. →

Added a second term with \* so it would search for the 1<sup>st</sup> two concepts with poetry OR poem OR poems. →

- Narrow your search by
  - Field** (drop down menu): Full-text, Author, Article Title, Abstract, and Caption.
    - Note:** there aren't many article abstracts in JSTOR.
  - Type:** Article, Review, Opinion Piece, etc.
  - Date Range:** Limit by year, month, and/or day ranges
  - Language:** English, Spanish, French, Latin, etc.
  - Discipline/Journal:** Limit your search to one or more discipline or journal.

### Article Locator

- Use this option to retrieve an article using specific citation information.

### Viewing, Printing, and Saving Results

View the article by clicking the title.

Click on the author's name to view all of his/her articles in JSTOR.

<b>Stable URL</b>	Use this URL for citations
<b>Article Information</b>	This link displays the article's full citation
<b>Page of First Match</b>	This link will take you directly to the page of where your search terms first appear.
<b>Print</b>	Select this link to print the article. <b>Be sure to print using the Adobe Acrobat button – not the browser's print button.</b>
<b>Download</b>	Select this link to save the article as either TIFF or PDF
<b>Save Citation</b>	This link will temporarily save the article information and you can proceed with searching and viewing articles. Go back to the citations by clicking "View Saved Citations".
